Supplies Provided:

- Acrylic Paint
- Paint Pens
- Paintbrush
- Rocks
- Wire
- Beads



Supplies Needed From Home:

• Glue or Mod Podge

Directions:

- 1. Rinse the rocks and set them to dry on a towel overnight.
- 2. Paint the rocks until it's the color you desire. It make take several coats.
- 3. Embellish the rocks with the paint pens if you want designs
- 4. Once the paint has dried for 24 hours, coat the rocks in Mod Podge or a mix of 6 oz of school glue and ½ cup of water. Dry for 24 hours.
- 5. Wrap a wire around a pen or marker a few times to make some loops. This is where the photo will be held. Add some beads and make another loop when you've finished adding them to keep them in place.

Directions continued:

6. Straighten out the rest of the wire underneath the loops. Wrap the rest of the wire around the stone.



7. Stick a photo in between the loops to hold it upright.
