Vernon Area Public Library Teen Take and Make Kits: Beeswax Sushi Candles

Supplies Provided:

- Beeswax
- Wick

Supplies Needed From Home:

- Ruler
- Knife/Scissors
- Blow Dryer
 - If the wax isn't bending well, heat with a blow dryer to make it softer, but make sure you don't melt it!



To make an onigiri:

- 1. Cut two 1 inch strips of white wax and set aside. If you're planning on "filling" the onigiri, cut 1 inch strips of the color(s) you'd like to fill it with, set aside.
- 2. If using a "filling," place the wick on the end of one color, then roll to desired size. Cut excess. Wrap with 2 strips of white beeswax into a triangle shape.
- 3. If you're only doing "rice," attach the wick to one end of a 1 inch strip of white beeswax, and roll into a triangle shape.
- 4. Cut a 1 inch strip of green and cut to your desired length and warm to stick to your "rice."
- 5. Cut the wick about 1 inch from the top of the candle.

To make a sushi roll:

- 1. Cut a 1 inch strip of green wax, and a 1 inch strip of white wax. For whichever color toppings you'd like, cut a 1 inch strip as well.
- 2. Roll the fillings first in small circles, then put a wick in between and press together.
- 3. Wrap the white beeswax in a circle around the filling. End with green. (You may need to cut it smaller.)
- 4. Cut the wick about 1 inch from the top of the candle.
